1. Brandon Santa – Requesting Sketch Plan Direction for a proposal to construct six (6) shop warehouse buildings along with other associated site improvements to be located on a 7.46-acre parcel at 0 Lakeshore Road (SBL #: 150.00-1-6.2)
2. Briad Development LLC – Requesting a Planning Board report and recommendation for the rezoning of a 4.14-acre parcel (SBL #: 160.18-1-9.1) from C-1 to C-2 for the development of a small-scale traveler center, anchored by an 8,700 sq-ft building to include several quick-service restaurant (QSR) establishments, separate fuel pump stations, and other associated parking and site improvements
