The Town of Hamburg offers portal-to-portal transportation service for the elderly as well as adults with disabilities requiring wheelchair accessibility.

Reservations -

- ♦ Medical appointments have priority.
- ♦ For medical appointments: may be made **up to one week** in advance.
- ♦ For non-medical appointments: must be made **24 hours** in advance.
- ♦ For Grocery Van and Lunch program: may be made **up to one week** in advance
- ♦ Grocery Van runs on Tuesdays & Thursdays

If you need to cancel or re-schedule your pick-up, please call dispatch 716-646-1666 as soon as possible.



Service Areas -

- ♦ **Local** – within Hamburg Township
- ♦ **Intermediate** - south of Clinton Road (Rt. 354), Eden, Derby
- ♦ **City/North** – north of Clinton Rd., south of Sheridan Drive (Rt. 324)

All areas west of Transit Road

Note: Intermediate & City/North are for medical purposes ONLY.



We attempt to accommodate all riders' requests or circumstances.

There may be times when we are unable to do so, whether it be due to inclement weather, road conditions, or when riders have appointments beyond our hours of operation.



General Rules -

- ♦ Drivers are not to enter into any residence beyond the immediate area inside the door as well as the entrance to apartment complex/medical building.
- ♦ You must be able to get into the vehicle under your own power. Drivers may assist you but are not to lift or support you.
- ♦ When in the vehicle:
 - ♦ Seat belts must be worn.
 - ♦ All riders are to remain seated while the vehicle is in motion.
 - ♦ Riders are to be courteous to the driver and other passengers.
 - ♦ There is to be no smoking, drinking or eating in the vehicle.
- ♦ **For Wheelchair users:**
 - ♦ At pick-up, wheelchair must be on ground level, if there is no ramp. Drivers are not to go up or down any steps with wheelchair.
