Town of Hamburg Recreation Department implements the following rules regarding disqualifications and ejections.

This policy will be in addition to the Code of Conduct and League Rules.

Disqualifications: the disqualified player must leave the game and sit on the bench. A disqualification may result from a player receiving one or more of six personal fouls, two technical fouls, and/or one flagrant technical foul.

Ejections: the ejected player must leave the premises. Failure to do so may result in further action. A disqualified player is not automatically ejected from the premises. A player will be ejected if he continues to act in an unsporting way once he is disqualified from the game.

First Ejection Offense: the ejected player must leave the premises in a timely manner and is suspended for the next game.

Repeat Ejection Offenses: the ejected player must leave the premises in a timely manner and is suspended indefinitely.

Repeat offenses may result in permanent suspension from season/league.

Suspensions: the suspended player is not allowed on the premises during the suspension.
