Mission Statement

The mission of the Traffic Safety Advisory Board (TSAB) is to provide community input by advising the Town Supervisor and Town Board, as well as other Town committees, on traffic issues, development proposals and special projects. The TSAB works collaboratively with Town staff and board members to respond to resident requests for improving vehicular and non-vehicular transportation routes on streets in Hamburg, NY. This Committee is advisory only, and will not have responsibility for any operational activities.

Responsibilities and Functions

The Traffic Safety Advisory Board will be responsible for promoting enhanced traffic safety in the Town of Hamburg by creating a forum where residents of the Town can voice traffic concerns, suggestions and requests, work with Town staff to examine alternatives to existing traffic situations, and identify long and short-term solutions to traffic issues in Hamburg.

TSAB meetings are held on the second Thursday of each month at 7PM in Town Hall Conference Room 7A/B.
