We have reviewed the Phase I Archaeological Investigation report prepared by Bonnie Locking (Locking, September 2021; 21SR00587) in accordance with the New York State Historic Preservation Act of 1980 (section 14.09 of the New York Parks, Recreation, and Historic Preservation Law). These comments are those of the Division for Historic Preservation and relate only to Historic/Cultural resources.
